The Morana rifle retains all the essential elements of the original rifle that is being modernized and overhauled. The Morana is of the same caliber and same operating system (semi-automatic or automatic) as the initial rifle specimen and retains the same serial number.

The modernization of the AK model Morana rifles can be carried out in two ways, according to the needs of the client: A complete modernization and overhaul involves restoring the rifle to its original and correct state with a change of barrel and application of structural solutions of the Morana model.

Partial modernization and overhaul involves restoring the rifle to its original and working condition and applying the Morana model's structural solutions.

Morana can be equipped with the widest range of modern optoelectronic precision enhancement devices with the use of mounting elements for Picatinny rails and the M-lok system. Also, the rifle can be equipped with a large selection of accessories to adapt to the ergonomic needs of the user when performing specific tasks.

The Morana rifle is a product of the modernization and overhaul of standard AK rifles, the most widespread system in the world. Morana with its design and technical solutions, retains all the features of the old proven AK system, with reduced weight and the application of new, modern firearms equipment solutions, giving new weapons the maximum flexibility in tailoring for individual needs according to the tasks set up ahead.
